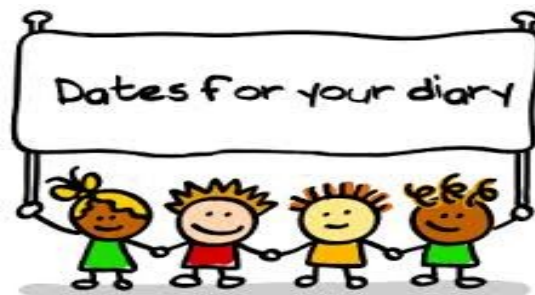

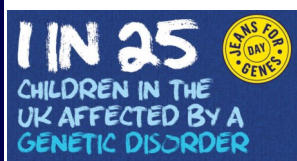

- Ask us to spell:** 'favourite', 'different' and 'because'
- Question us** The Equator and the Tropics
- about if we can** Key countries in Europe OR What happens in our reading book
- remember:** 'Around the World in 80 days?'

Topic: Our Planet



- Test us on our:** Place Value TTH, TH, H,T,O
- Talk to us about:** Life cycles, Biomes and our planet
- Ask us to spell:** 'amphibian', 'science' and 'climate'
- Question us** The Girl who Lost a Leopard
- about if we can** The three climate zones, What 900 is in Roman numerals?

Topic: Monumental Maya

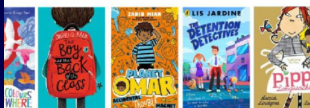


- Test us on our:** Knowledge of place value and rounding
